## Grant Project Description

The Victims Services Team in the Division of Programs and Services is requesting a second year of funding for a collaborative endeavor with the Virginia Sexual and Domestic Violence Action Alliance and the Virginia Department of Social Services known as the “Underserved Populations Learning Collaborative” (UPLC). This project will increase access and improve service provision to underserved populations by connecting sexual and domestic violence agencies and community-based organizations, through an intensive 18-month guided process.

## Project Performance to Date (if Continuation)

The first cohort of the UPLC started on August 1, 2018, with 20 participating agencies. In the first five months of the project, all 20 agencies completed assessments and pre-work assignments, had in-person meetings with the project coaches, and attended a two-day learning session. Funding will continue supporting the project as the 20 agencies complete the second and third six-month learning periods.
