We will do this with the purchase of a 3D scanner that limits the time and physical presence of the investigators on the scene reducing their exposure limits. 3D scanning technology allows for the rapid acquisition of highly detailed 3D models of a physical environment. In addition, the technology will enable investigators to analyze crime scenes at a later point in time with a scanned 3D model. 3D laser scanning technology is being used to accurately depict the relational aspect of each piece of evidence so investigators can rebuild and reconstruct crime scenes.
