Re: FY25 VDSS Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) VOCA Grant

The purpose of the FY25 VDSS Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) Grant is to provide pass-through funding to local CAC programs that meet the following eligibility requirements:

- The program must be operational and have trained forensic interviewers available to assist child victims of crime at the time of application.
- The program must be in full compliance with state and national (NCA) accreditation standards.
- For VOCA funding eligibility, funds must be used for direct services to victims of child abuse. Examples of eligible victim groups are:
 - Children who have self-reported as a victim of abuse to a caregiver or trusted adult.
 - Children who have been identified by local law enforcement or departments of social services as victims of child abuse.
 - Children who have been referred to law enforcement or local departments of social services as possible victims of child abuse are also eligible if the referral results in an investigation or family assessment (must be determined a valid complaint).
 - Children identified by the court as victims of abuse.

This is a continuation grant to the Virginia Department of Social Services. Because of the reduction in VOCA funding, DCJS invited them to apply for a total of \$1,875,000 (\$1,500,000 VOCA funding request/\$375,000 match).

In summary, DCJS staff request approval to fund one continuation grant in the amount of \$1,500,000 in federal funds.
