Re: Sexual Assault Services Program, Calendar Year 2024

The purpose of the Sexual Assault Services Program (SASP) is to support the establishment, maintenance, and expansion of rape crisis centers and other nongovernmental or tribal programs and projects to assist individuals who have been victimized by sexual assault, without regard to the age of the individual (34 U.S.C. §12511(b)(2)(B)). SASP funding originates from the U.S. Department of Justice's Office on Violence Against Women.

This Calendar Year (CY) 2024 funding is a one-time competitive funding opportunity for a 12-month grant, with the possibility of two, level-funded continuation grants for calendar years 2025 and 2026 if funding is available. DCJS received 31 applications with requests totaling \$1,342,909.00. The requests for funds from the applicants exceeded the funds available to award by \$352,312.00.

Applications were scored separately by two DCJS staff members. All 31 applications are recommended for funding, however; all are recommended at decreased amounts due to the lack of available funding, how their applications scored, and unallowable items in some of the budgets.

In summary, DCJS staff **request approval to fund 31 projects** for the 12-month period (1/1/2024–12/31/2024), **totaling \$990,597.00**, using federal SASP funds designated for this purpose.

Grant Project Description

ACTS Sexual Assault Services is the only comprehensive services for victims of sexual assault in Prince William County. This SASP project will partially fund 4 positions: A Program Director: 7 hours per week, Bilingual Sexual Assault Specialist: 9 hours per week, a Sexual Assault Specialist: 9 hours per week, and our hourly Sexual Assault Intake Specialist: 7 hours per week. These positions provide supportive sexual assault services such as individual and group support, as well as medical, legal, and law enforcement accompaniment for 30 sexual assault victims and their families. Outreach will target underserved populations and include at least 2 community events that emphasize and celebrate diverse cultures and traditions.

Grant Project Description

Requested SASP funds will be used to provide wages for a qualified professional to deliver direct services to 35 survivors of sexual assault and their non-offending family members annually. This position will prioritize children and youth survivors of the Latinx and African American communities. The services will include victim advocacy, crisis intervention as well as individual and group counseling. From January 1, 2022 -to December 30, 2022, the Sexual Assault Center served 101 youth ages 5-24. SASP grant funds will be used to supplement existing funds and will not replace (supplant) funds that have been appropriated for the purpose of providing services to victims of sexual assault.

Grant Project Description

Our project, Strengthening Support for Spanish-Speaking Survivors of Sexual Assault, is dedicated to providing essential services to Spanish-speaking victims of sexual violence in Virginia.
