Mental Health America of Roanoke Valley is expanding its Super Hero Kids program, which provides a therapeutic curriculum for youth survivors of domestic violence. It is a weekly program occurring during the academic year, and it comprises a summer camp as well. Traditionally the program served youth ages 5-12, but we are now expanding it to include ages 13-17 as well. Weekly sessions are divided into age-appropriate groups. Super Hero Kids Program Director Leah Okraszewski is responsible for program participants as well as interns from Community High School and adult volunteers. In order to reach capacity of 30 youth clients served per year, the Program Director position is being expanded to full-time and a part-time staff member will be hired for the program. The curriculum of Super Hero Kids is based on nationally recognized trauma-informed therapeutics and coping techniques and structured based on Renee Emunah's drama therapy model. Youth will learn to identify their emotions and develop coping skills and healthy, creative expression of those emotions through play, the creative arts, and other modalities. The Harassment Advocacy Group (HAG) will be an advocacy group for survivors of non-sexual harassment (workplace or community) and stalking. Support groups provide a safe space for individuals to meet other people who are dealing with similar issues and discuss how to better cope with their situations. An advocacy group goes further and creates a space where individual members not only glean support, but also gather tools to help themselves feel empowered to move forward in their lives. This group will decrease members' sense of isolation, provide emotional support, and encourage healthy coping strategies to deal with stressful life events. It will also work with members to be active participants in their own treatment, and expose them to community resources for which they can take advantage. By sharing their stories and feelings, group members learn that they are not alone and help one another to overcome feelings of frustration, loneliness, and despair. By learning about how to take advantage of the resources in their community, group members learn they do not have to be silent victims of a tormentor in their life.
