Crime victims have certain rights under Virginia's Crime Victim and Witness Rights Act (Title 19.2, Chapter 1.1). As the victim of a crime, you may be entitled to assistance in obtaining protection and protective orders, financial assistance, advanced notice of court proceedings, restitution, and other related assistance. Your local victim/witness program, commonwealth's attorney's office, and/or law enforcement agency can help and provide information about your rights.
