Grant Project Description

The DFS Training Section provides training to law enforcement focusing on the recognition, collection and preservation of evidence at crime scenes. Annually, approximately 25 programs of various lengths and complexities are offered, resulting in the provision of forensic technical training to an average of 650 officers and crime scene specialists. Typically, there are waiting lists for many of these courses. As a result of budget reductions in 2008, the training staff was reduced to one forensic trainer and one training manager. During the two sessions of the Forensic Science Academy (FSA), nine weeks each, staff and equipment are too limited to offer short courses at the same time.

DFS seeks to restore its third FSA session (eliminated in 2008) and to offer short courses concurrently with each FSA session. The addition of staff and equipment will help to minimize the waiting list for short courses and the FSA. DFS seeks funding to procure the equipment necessary to each a Basic Crime Scene Photo course, which is the most requested short course. DFS also seeks funding to support a part-time instructor to teach short courses.

Grant Project Description

The Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) is requesting funding to continue the adoption of Effective Practices in Community Supervision (EPICS) in court service units across the states. EPICS teaches probation and parole officers how to translate the “what works” research from theory to practice. Currently, nineteen of thirty-three court service units have been trained on EPICS. Funding will allow the agency to train 60 probation and parole officers from four additional court service units: the 23A District Court Service Unit – Roanoke, the 23rd District Court Service Unit – Salem, the 25th District Court Service Unit – Staunton, and the 31st District Court Service Unit – Manassas / Prince William. The EPICS training is delivered in a three day format with heavy participation and practice opportunities. After the training, probation and parole officers and their supervisors begin practicing their newly acquired skills during their individual interactions with probation, parole and direct care juveniles assigned to their caseloads. Funding will be utilized to contract with the University of Cincinnati Corrections Institute (UCCI), the developer of the EPICS curriculum, to provide training to staff. Funding will also purchase 18 digital recorders for use by probation officers and supervisors to improve skills and promote consistency.
