Grant Project Description

These funds are used to pay the salary related expenses and travel to support the staff members responsible for assuring Virginia's compliance with the core requirements of the JJDP Act. Virginia, through DCJS, is required to make annual reports to the Administrator of Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention on the results of our monitoring efforts. Historically, the positions were funded out of the administrative portion of the JJDP Act funds. Due to significant reductions in funding awarded to Virginia under this program, we no longer have sufficient funds to support all the necessary staff. Shifting the compliance monitoring from the administrative portion of the grant to grant funds enables Virginia to continue to comply with the JJDP Act and its administrative requirements.

Project Performance to Date (if Continuation)

Since October site visits have been made to 23 courthouses, jails, lock-ups and 22 juvenile detention centers to monitor compliance with the JJDP Act. The bulk of the compliance monitoring will be done during the remainder of the grant cycle which ends September 30, 2018. The Annual OJJDP Compliance Report was completed and submitted on schedule. Compliance Monitor Stables attended the quarterly meetings of the ACJJP and the Virginia Juvenile Detention Association.
