The program begins with the offender "Finding his Identify" in the first phase, followed by a phase dedicated to life skills building in order to reenter into the community successfully, and ending with a phase that focuses on the offender becoming service oriented by working within the community. The goals for this program include assisting the offender in overcoming addiction, preparing the offenders for reentry to society, and teaching skills needed to deter re-offending in this population.
