Grant Project Description

Project COURAGE (Creating Opportunities for Understanding and Resilience Amid Gaining our Education) provides a multifaceted approach to supporting 65 students who have experienced crime based traumas. The Behavioral Health Coach will conduct assessments, creating behavioral plans, observing classrooms to see if changes can be made to reduce trauma responses and referral coordination. The anxiety/depression specialist will utilize the COPE program to help students deal with the effects of trauma and the Mentoring Coordinator will do group mentoring and train individual mentors to support students. Teachers will receive the signs of trauma training to create referrals and trauma informed classrooms.
