The program anticipates serving 90 children and 90 adults including victims of federal crimes in both the Hampton and Williamsburg Office. It is anticipated that 90% of children and 8-% of adults will report a reduction of Post-Traumatic stress symptoms as measured by CPSS V (for children) and the NSESSS (for adults), as compared to pre-treatment scores, after 8 weeks of treatment.
