FPCPD will partner with three Jewish organizations - a synagogue, a community center, and a school - to improve their security in hopes of deterring and detecting threats and attacks thus reducing or eliminating damage from a Hate Crime. Congregation Olam Tikvah will replace three exterior access doors to preschool hallways and add security film to the glass door panels. Pozez Jewish Community Center will undertake a foundational cabling project to support and protect its network systems, the Personally Identifiable Information (PII) it stores, and the users who engage on its platforms. Gesher Jewish Day School will undertake a cyber-security assessment of their systems and will purchase three 8-Pack bleeding control kits.
