As tensions between racial and ethnic groups rise and tribalism remains a prevalent force in our society, Loudoun County reaffirms its commitment to protect its citizens against hate-based attacks. As Loudoun's population has grown to surpass 400,000, the community has also diversified significantly. These factors have led to a rise in active hate groups and threats against minority faith-based groups. Loudoun seeks \$196,783 to assist four congregations in target-hardening measures at their houses of worship and provide evidence-based security training for partners to increase situational awareness, assess risks, and mitigate potential hate-based incidents. The county will administer funding and provide support to meet these goals.

Grant Project Description

FCPD will partner with three Jewish organizations - a synagogue, a community center, and a school ? to improve their security in hopes of deterring and detecting threats and attacks thus reducing or eliminating damage from a Hate Crime. Congregation Olam Tikvah will replace exterior access. Pozez Jewish Community Center will purchase an electronic visitor management system, improve classroom doors and locks and replace aging exterior doors. Gesher Jewish Day School will undertake a cyber-security assessment, install a perimeter fence and hire a second security guard. All three organizations are partnering to purchase training equipment to support comprehensive preparedness and response training for staff and constituents.
