The need to create community resources, within the 25th District JDR Court that are responsive and streamlined to reduce status offenders has become imperative. This change is precipitated by (1) the desire to reduce status offenders, (2) the needed to reduce the amount of truancy petitions, (3) the needed to reduce court/probation personnel workload related to truancy, and (4) the need to reduce the workload of multidisciplinary Family Assessment and Planning Teams. The Office on Youth proposes to address the high rate of truant status offenders by expanding the Check and Connect truancy prevention program and establishing a Community Truancy Board.
