Re: Byrne/JAG - Option 5 Out-of-State Lateral Training Program

The purpose of Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") funds is to allow states and units of local government, including tribes, to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime based on their own state and local needs and conditions. As the State Administrative Agency (SAA), DCJS has the responsibility of managing the coordination and distribution of JAG funds in a manner that supports and improves the overall criminal justice system of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This funding opportunity was used to fund reasonable expenses associated with operating an Option 5 Out-of-State Lateral Training Program through the Fairfax County Criminal Justice Training Academy.

For this funding opportunity, DCJS received and reviewed one (1) application. Staff is requesting approval to award \$129,524.00 in federal JAG funds to support Option 5 Academy at the Fairfax County Criminal Justice Training Academy.

No applications were denied for this JAG funding opportunity.

In summary, DCJS staff request approval to fund one (1) award, totaling \$129,524.00, for an 18-month period (4.1.2024-12.31.2025), using federal JAG funds allocated for this purpose.
