FEE:	The exhibit fee (\$250.00-non-profit, \$500.00-standard) includes the above provisions, conference registration (exhibitors are welcome to attend plenary sessions and workshops). No refunds can be made after May 11, 2018	
GENERAL:	Exhibitors may not sublet or assign their space to others. Combustible materials or explosives are prohibited; fire extinguishers and exits must not be obstructed. Sounds from audio machines must be subdued and not disturb other exhibitors. Exhibitors shall pay for any damages to property owned by Norfolk Waterside Marriott Hotel resulting from any act or omission of Exhibitor.
