## Subject: New and Updated Behavioral Threat Assessment and Management (BTAM) Resources

To provide ongoing assistance and resources to threat assessment teams, the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) is pleased to provide the following new and updated BTAM resources:

## 1. Behavioral Threat Assessment Resource Toolkits for schools and parents

The goal of the toolkits is twofold. First, to provide ready access to these valuable threat assessment resources. Second, to provide a link to new videos that help threat assessment teams meet the legislative requirements in the *Code of Virginia*, section C of § 22.1-79.4 to provide guidance to students, faculty, and staff regarding recognition of threatening or aberrant behavior that may represent a threat to the community, school, or self.
