### MEMORANDUM

TO: American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) / Victims Services Grant Program (VSGP) Grant Recipients

SUBJECT: Additional American Rescue Plan Act Funds

---

In June, Virginia's 2022-2024 biennium budget was finalized. Included in the budget is the following American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) appropriations language ([Item 486 #7c](#)):

*\$6,000,000 the first year and \$3,000,000 the second year to the Department of Criminal Justice Services (140) to support services to victims of crime including, but not limited to, services for victims of sexual assault and domestic violence. The department shall use these funds to support sexual assault and domestic violence applicants of the Victims Services Grant Program.*

As one of the "sexual assault and domestic violence applicants of the Victims Services Grant Program," your agency is eligible for this funding. Congratulations on receiving these additional ARPA funds!

On July 21, 2022, the Executive Committee of the Criminal Justice Services Board voted to approve \$6,000,000 in additional funding to 59 sexual and domestic violence agencies. The list of awards and amounts is included with this memorandum.

DCJS Grants Management will reissue a Statement of Grant Award (SOGA) for your current ARPA grant with a new award amount to include the additional funding for State Fiscal Year 2023. The additional funds will be available for your use retroactive to July 1, 2022. Also, your updated SOGA will extend your grant award end date to June 30, 2023.

After receiving, signing, and returning the signed SOGA to DCJS, you will need to update your ARPA budget in OGMS with the new, larger amount. We will send you instructions on how to do this with the SOGA.

During SFY 2023, you will continue to submit quarterly expenditure reports. You will also need to submit an end-of-the-year progress report for SFY 2023 by July 15, 2023. Additional information and instructions will be provided later in the fiscal year.
