Patrick County Sheriff's Office

9-18-2020

On 09-18-2020 the Patrick County Sheriff's Office (PCSO) worked drug interdiction. The PCSO used 5 PCSO Officers starting at 18:00 hours until 00:00 hours for a total of six hours. During the 6 hours PCSO Officers conducted several traffic stops along with an approved traffic checking detail. During the traffic stop period Offices were able to make an informant. The informant provided information where a wanted subject was hiding for the distribution of Methamphetamine. Officers were able to locate and arrest the wanted subject without incident due to the information the informant provided. During the traffic checking details Offices gave several warnings for minor traffic infractions.

9-25-2020

On 9-25-2020 the PCSO worked drug interdiction. The PCSO used 5 PCSO Officers starting at 1800 hours until 00:00 hours for a total of six hours. During the 6 hours Officers worked a PCSO CI. The CI was able to purchase Methamphetamine. Two well known drug dealers were part of the drug transaction. The subjects will be indicted at later date. Officer's assisted with a pursuit that ended with two arrests. Officers stopped a vehicle that produced a needle during an inventory search. An arrest was made for driving while suspended DUI related. The subject found with needle and arrested advised they are interested in becoming a Confidential Informant. Several warnings were issued for minor traffic infractions. Several consent searches were conducted during traffic stops.
