3. How was the purchased equipment or technology resources used toward achieving your project goals and objectives? On January 26th, 2020 a major crime investigation for a homicide at True Gospel Baptist Church in Stuart, Virginia was initiated. Through multiple interrogations Patrick County investigators determined the murder was a result of a drug deal feud. After hours of interviews, interrogations, and crime scene processing investigators discovered one-half pound of Marijuana and a 9mm handgun that was hidden at the crime scene. After hours more of interviews and interrogations investigators applied for and were granted a Commonwealth of Virginia Search Warrant for a residence in Patrick County, Virginia. Intelligence indicated that drugs, firearms and wanted persons were located at the residence. The Patrick County Tactical Response Team was called in to execute the warrant. During the search warrant approximately one pound of marijuana, smoking devices, packaging materials, firearms and other evidence was collected. The search warrant also revealed one of the individuals wanted in connection to the murder. Hours more of interrogations and interviews were conducted that revealed the circumstances that lead to the homicide. Ultimately four adults and one juvenile were arrested in relation to the incident. Two adults were charged with murder 2nd degree, use of firearm in commission of felony, reckless handling of firearm, and use/possession of firearm in proximity of school property. One adult was charged with possession of more than 1/2 ounce of Marijuana with intent to distribute. One adult was charged with robbery, use of firearm in commission of felony, and possession of 1/2 ounce of Marijuana with intent to distribute. The juvenile was charged with conspiracy to distribute more than 1/2 ounce of Marijuana and robbery. The entire law enforcement section of the Patrick County Sheriff's Office were deployed to assist in the various elements of this complex investigation. Over one pound of Marijuana, and three firearms were seized during the investigation and search warrant.
