Subaward Project Description: **The Department of Forensic Science received funding in FY 17 to increase capacity in the Forensic Training Section by hiring a part-time instructor and by adding equipment necessary to teach a Basic Digital Crime Scene Photo course concurrently with the Forensic Science Academy. This increase capacity allowed the Section to add a third session of the FSA and one additional Basic Crime Scene Photo course, thereby training more officers yearly without having to reduce the number of short courses. This project was continued in the FY18 and FY19 grant cycles, during which DFS was able to add several additional short courses. It is the intent of the DFS Forensic Training Section to maintain this capacity by continuing to offer a third session of the FSA and additional short courses yearly. Therefore, continuation funding is requested to retain the part-time instructor and to purchase additional auxiliary equipment items. The purchase of these items is a proactive measure to avoid possibly delays in the instruction time in the event of equipment malfunction. Funds are also requested for travel costs for the part-time instructor to conduct short courses outside of the Richmond area, and for hotel reimbursement for law enforcement officers who assist in FSA instruction.**

The Sheriff's Office is trying to better prepare its officers to respond to emergency situations that require additional protection that is currently outside the agencies current operating budget. This grant would allow the agency to provide helmets (Paraclete Operator Elite with 4D Pads) to all of our emergency responding personnel to allow for added head protection during many different types of emergency calls or calls involving Civil Unrest. We would also like to purchase 4 ballistic shields to provide a safer response to patrol units and allow a more rapid deployment of this type of equipment in the field and help to reduce response/entry times into high-risk calls and provide an additional layer of protection for those officers making entry. The purchase of a Rescue phone Quad and Rescue Phone Sniper Video System will allow our Crisis Negotiations Unit to use this equipment to be able to communicate with an individual during a barricade type situation and would allow video to observe what is going on in the interior of a building and provide more intelligence to the Emergency Responses Team in their planning to maintain the safest environment possible for responders and those involved in the situation. This equipment would also be available to assist King William Sheriff's Office and the West Point Police Department as our Emergency Responses Team routinely assists with these types of calls in King William and West Point. The purchase and installation of the Flir Camera for the Special Operations Vehicle would allow Commanders using the Special Operations Vehicle to have video observation of an emergency scene.
