The Department of Forensic Science received funding in FY 17 to increase capacity in the Forensic Training Section by hiring a part-time instructor and by adding equipment necessary to teach a Basic Digital Crime Scene Photo course concurrently with the Forensic Science Adacemy. This increase capacity allowed the Section to add a third session of the FSA and one additional Basic Crime Scene Photo course, thereby training more officers yearly without having to reduce the number of short courses. This project was continued in the FY18 and FY19 grant cycles, during which DFS was able to add several additional short courses. It is the intent of the DFS Forensic Training Section to maintain this capacity by continuing to offer a thrid sessoin of the FSA and additional short courses yearly. Therefore, continuation funding is requested to retain the part-time instructor and to purchase additional auxiliary equipment items.
