This grant would allow the agency to provide helmets (Paraclete Operator Elite with 4D Pads) to all of our emergency responding personnel to allow for added head protection during many different types of emergency calls or calls involving Civil Unrest. We would also like to purchase 4 ballistic shields to provide a safer response to patrol units and allow a more rapid deployment of this type of equipment in the field and help to reduce response/entry times into high-risk calls and provide an additional layer of protection for those officers making entry. The purchase of a Rescue phone Quad and Rescue Phone Sniper Video System will allow our Crisis Negotiations Unit to use this equipment to be able to communicate with an individual during a barricade type situation and would allow video to observe what is going on in the interior of a building and provide more intelligence to the Emergency Reponses Team in their planning to maintain the safest environment possible for responders and those involved in the situation.
