  - Law (Knowledge of State and Federal Courts, Legal Terminology and Definitions, US Constitution - Bill of Rights, and Limitations and Liability)
  - Legal Procedures and Due Process
  - Civil Law
  - Criminal Law
- **Basic Law - 4 hours**
- **Laws Regarding the Use of Force/Liability Issues - 4 hours**
- **Obtaining an Arrest Warrant/Virginia Uniform Summons - 4 hours**
- **Rules of Evidence - 1 hour**
- **Court Room Testimony - 1 hour**

### **Employee Requirements for the SCOP Program**

- Must apply for the SCOP program through the company
- Must have an endorsement / sponsorship from the employee's direct supervisor
- No previous corrective counselling or disciplinary reviews
- Excellent performance reviews in functions and duties of a security officer
- Must demonstrate competent knowledge of criminal law
- Must maintain security registration, including armed security (arrest authority), and all subsequent firearms endorsements
- Previous SCOP 06E training reviewed
- Six (6) month review and training process
