

Appendix A:

Pedestrian Stop Volumes by Agency

Table A1 shows, for each of the 161 agencies with at least one stop in the analysis dataset, the volume of stops for each subject racial/ethnic group and the total number of stops. The numbers of stops reported by each agency will vary due to stop volumes in each area, and because different agencies reported data for different periods of time for the fiscal year July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022 (that is, some agencies with high stop volumes may have reported fewer stops than agencies with lower volumes because the high-volume agency may have reported only six months of data). The number of days of data reported for each agency (“Stop Days”) is also shown in the tables (365 days = July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022), and is calculated by the difference between each agency’s earliest and latest recorded stops.
