

Appendix F:

Pedestrian Data Collection Survey Instructions and Results

This Appendix contains the agency guidance for the pedestrian survey factors and a full listing of the survey results by agency. Factors are displayed in the results table using their Question ID (Q1, Q2, etc.). Refer to the guidance page or Table 10 of the Pedestrian Supplement to match Question IDs to the text of each question. Agencies who did not respond to the survey are not listed in the results table.

Agencies who reported no stops for FY22 had two options to select in the survey question about their participation in pedestrian data collection: “No (Zero Stops in FY22)” or “No (unable to participate/did not participate in reporting).” This breakdown helps to highlight the number of agencies with current barriers to collecting and reporting pedestrian data, versus agencies which simply did not have any pedestrian stops that they determined to be relevant for CPA reporting. In the survey results listing, the latter responses are abbreviated to “No (DNP).” The survey skipped the Higher Collection Volume Factors portion for any agency who gave either “No” response concerning FY22 collection; this is represented in the results table with “N/A (No Stops Reported).” Because collection factors may have led some agencies to report zero cases for FY22, all respondents were prompted to complete the Lower Collection Volume Factors portion of the survey.

Survey Guidance on Specific Questionnaire Factors

The following notes offer background and guidance on individual factors in the questionnaire. Note that if you are uncertain whether a certain factor applies to your agency, you may leave the factor unmarked. Do not mark any factor for which you have already resolved the issue and successfully resubmitted the stop data per the VSP review process.

Lower Collection Volume Factors

Q1: Stops that result in No Enforcement Action are less likely to be collected. Some agencies' CPA data collection processes may only create a record for certain pedestrian stops if they result in an arrest or summons. Mark this factor if stop record creation for "No Enforcement Action" is a manual process for the officer involved and may not be consistently recorded.

Q2: Non "stop and frisks" resulting in arrest or summons are not collected or are under-collected (§ 52-30.2C vs § 15.2-1609.10B/§ 15.2-1722.1B). The language of the CPA pertaining to which stops must be collected and reported varies under several separate code sections. Under § 52-30.2C, all Virginia law enforcement officers are mandated to collect data "Each time a law-enforcement officer or State Police officer stops a driver of a motor vehicle, stops and frisks a person based on reasonable suspicion, *or temporarily detains a person during any other investigatory stop.*" However, § 15.2-1609.10B and § 15.2-1722.1B (pertaining to Virginia Sheriff's Offices and Police Departments, respectively) each state that agencies must collect CPA data for "(i) all investigatory motor vehicle stops, (ii) all stop-and-frisks of a person based on reasonable suspicion, and (iii) *all other investigatory detentions that do not result in an arrest or the issuance of a summons.*" Because the different code sections state different requirements on whether to collect data on investigatory detentions that DO result in an arrest or summons, some agencies may be collecting this subset of cases, while some agencies may be excluding them. This factor applies for any agency which is more aligned with §15.2-1609.10B/§15.2-1722.1B and has opted to generally exclude "other investigatory detentions" that result in an arrest or summons.

Q3: Not all officers are consistently able to collect/report pedestrian stops. Some agencies may have technical issues accessing their CPA collection systems for certain pedestrian stops (network connectivity issues in certain areas, bike patrol vs. vehicle patrol, etc.) or other practical barriers for each officer to consistently report all of their stops. If you believe that such an issue has prevented your agency from reporting the full volume of their pedestrian stops, select this factor.

Q4: Specific offenses are systematically not collected or undercollected (Please specify). Similar to the above factor, some specific pedestrian offenses may present challenges to consistently collecting and reporting CPA data. Using offense descriptions, statute codes, and/or Virginia Crime Codes, please list any offense(s) for which your agency may not be able to consistently collect a CPA stop record.

Q5: Person Searched field is not always marked "Y" for stops with a search. The Person Searched field is the only means by which DCJS can identify whether a search of the subject occurred as a result of the stop. Ideally, this field would be marked "Y" for every Terry Stop involving a frisk and for every stop involving a search of the subject. If this is not the case in your agency's data, please mark this factor.

Q6: Pedestrian stops are sometimes recorded as traffic (Person Type "D" or "P"). The Person Type field is the main indicator on whether a given stop involved a driver, passenger, or pedestrian/individual. The DCJS pedestrian data report will only include records which were marked "F" (pedestrian/individual) for

the Person Type. Mark this factor if you believe that your agency's data includes pedestrian/individual cases that were mistakenly marked as "D" or "P" for the person type.

Q7: Cases logged as "Call for Service" include officer-initiated stops. While the VSP data collection requirements of the CPA are broadly written to include stops which may have been initiated by a call for service, best practices for the analysis of potential bias in stop data involve excluding stops that are not officer-initiated from the analysis dataset. To accomplish this, DCJS removes all records with the Reason for Stop field marked as "Call for Service" from the analysis dataset. However, some agencies may be using the Call for Service stop type in a broader scope which includes stops initiated by the officer, which would lead DCJS to erroneously remove officer-initiated stops from the analysis dataset. If your agency data includes stops marked Call for Service which were initiated by the officer, select this factor.

Q8: Data includes only pedestrian subjects who are part of public foot traffic. While DCJS and VSP often use the term "pedestrian" to refer to stop subjects in the CPA data who are not drivers or passengers, the CPA statute does not mention the term "pedestrian" and the VSP CPA collection standards broadly define the Person Type "F" to include "pedestrian/individual." If your agency has submitted only cases involving a subject involved in public foot traffic (versus someone under investigatory detention within a private business or at home, for example), mark this factor.

Higher Collection Volume Factors

Q9: Data include cases where reason for stop was not "investigatory" per the VSP guidance (service of existing warrant, eviction, etc.). The language of the CPA mandates the collection of "investigatory" stops, but does not precisely define the term "investigatory." Given this ambiguity, VSP has included guidelines in their Collection Instructions and Technical Specifications (Version 4 onward) which reference existing Virginia case law and offer a general explanation of what may constitute investigative detention. While this guidance is not meant to supersede your agency legal team's own interpretation of the CPA requirements, it does provide a starting point for DCJS to compare agency collection practices. Please reference the [VSP guidance \(pgs. 7 and 8\)](#) to determine if your agency collected cases generally identified as not requiring collection, and mark this factor if so.

Q10: Data includes consensual subject encounters. Select this factor if your agency's data includes cases in which the subject was "free to go" and never officially detained.

Q11: Some Stops that are not officer-initiated are not logged as Calls for Service. While the VSP data collection requirements of the CPA are broadly written to include stops which may have been initiated by a call for service, best practices for the analysis of potential bias in stop data involve excluding stops that are not officer-initiated from the analysis dataset. To accomplish this, DCJS removes all records with the Reason for Stop field marked as "Call for Service" from the analysis dataset. However, some agencies may be recording stops initiated by dispatch or a call for service under a stop type other than Call for Service, which would lead DCJS to retain non officer-initiated stops in the analysis dataset. If your agency data includes calls for service/stops not initiated by the officer under a Reason for Stop other than Call for Service, select this factor.

Q12: Traffic stops sometimes recorded as pedestrian (Person Type "F"). The Person Type field is the main indicator on whether a given stop involved a driver, passenger, or pedestrian/individual. The DCJS

pedestrian data report will include all records which were marked "F" (pedestrian/individual) for the Person Type. Mark this factor if you believe that your agency's data includes passenger or driver cases that were mistakenly marked as "F" for the person type.

Q13: CPA Record System duplicates stop records per each charge/suspected offense. Some agencies may produce charge-level data that is submitted to VSP with multiple records when a single stop results in multiple charges. DCJS and VSP are able to flag these cases when they use the same CPA Record ID, but in some cases these duplicate records may each have unique Record IDs. Mark this factor if your agency submitted duplicate pedestrian records which did not share the same CPA Record ID.

Q14: Stops of mopeds, motorized scooters, bicycles, etc. would generally be recorded as Pedestrian: This factor asks you to identify your agency's general collection practices for subjects using some form of transportation other than a conventional motor vehicle. If these cases are logged using the Person Type "F" mark this factor. If they are logged as Person Type "D" or "P", do not mark this factor.

Q15: Departmental decision to err to the side of "overcollection" given uncertainty of investigatory detention definition. This factor is a more general statement to represent any combination of higher collection volume factors which you cannot identify with certainty. Either by choices in automatic record generation and collection, or through training and instruction to sworn officers, this factor indicates that your department is submitting a broad scope of stops of individuals in lieu of a precise definition of "temporary investigatory detentions." This factor is most appropriate if you feel that your agency is collecting cases beyond the requirements of the CPA, but cannot identify specific patterns or practices.
