

Supplantation

Supplanting means to deliberately reduce the amount of federal, state, or local funds currently being appropriated to an existing program or activity, because a DCJS grant has also been awarded for the same purposes. When the Subrecipient replaces funds in this manner, it reduces the total amount that would have been available for the stated grant purpose, and the substitution results in supplanting.

DCJS funds should be used to supplement existing funds for program activities and not replace funds that have been appropriated for the same purpose. Supplanting is strictly prohibited for all DCJS grant funds.
