
LGBT INDIVIDUALS: BY THE NUMBERS

AGE AT TIME OF FIRST RAPE AMONG FEMALE SURVIVORS



- 12% < 11 YEARS
- 30% 11-17 YEARS
- 37% 18-24 YEARS
- 14% 25-34 YEARS
- 5% 35-44 YEARS
- 2% > 44 YEARS

ADULTS WHO IDENTIFY AS LGBT IN THE U.S.

OF TRANSGENDER INDIVIDUALS HAVE EXPERIENCED SEXUAL ASSAULT WITHIN THEIR LIFETIME

MALE SURVIVORS EXPERIENCED THEIR FIRST RAPE AT OR BEFORE THE AGE OF 10

WOMEN WHO HAVE BEEN RAPED IN THEIR LIFETIME (APPROXIMATE AMOUNTS)

TRANSGENDER INDIVIDUALS HAVE BEEN HOMELESS BECAUSE OF THEIR GENDER IDENTITY



OF TRANSGENDER INDIVIDUALS WHO TRIED TO ACCESS HOMELESS SHELTERS WERE HARASSED, WHILE 29% OF THEM WERE TURNED AWAY ALTOGETHER

OF TRANSGENDER INDIVIDUALS WHO ACCESSED HOMELESS SHELTERS WERE SEXUALLY ASSAULTED BY RESIDENTS OR STAFF

GENDER AND SEXUAL MINORITY RELATIONSHIPS




Power and Control

- Threatening to "out" you
- Refusing to use your correct pronouns
- Questioning if you're a "real" man/woman or a "real" lesbian. etc.
- Using their ability to "pass" to discredit you
- Accusing you of cheating because you are attracted to multiple genders
