










Let me share with you some eye-opening statistics of male abuse in our society:

- One in every seven victims of sexual assault is under the age of six. *
- One in every seven victims or sexual assault is under the age of six. *
 One in four victims of sexual assault under the age of twelve is a boy.*
 Victims of rape and attempted rape who did not report to the police did not report for a number of reasons. 43% of victims did not report because they though that nothing could be done. 27%, thought it was a private matter, 12% were afraid of the police response, and 12% felt it was not important enough to report.
 As of 1998, 2.78 million men in the U.S. had been victims of attempted or completed rape."
- About 3% of American men—or 1 in 33—have experienced an attempted or completed rape in their lifetime.**
- 1 out of every 10 rape victims are male. " Stats from:
