Current Projects

- Converting the current CORE competencies training program from Instructor led training (ILT) to Virtual instructor led training (VILT). This process will be done with collaborated efforts between TAG, Instructional Design Specialist, and DCJS Adult Justice Programs.
- Recruiting and retaining TAG members and Trainers.
- Incorporating Trauma Informed Care and Human Trafficking into CORE curriculum.
- Identifying additional training needs for the field.
